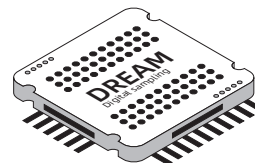

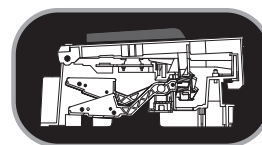

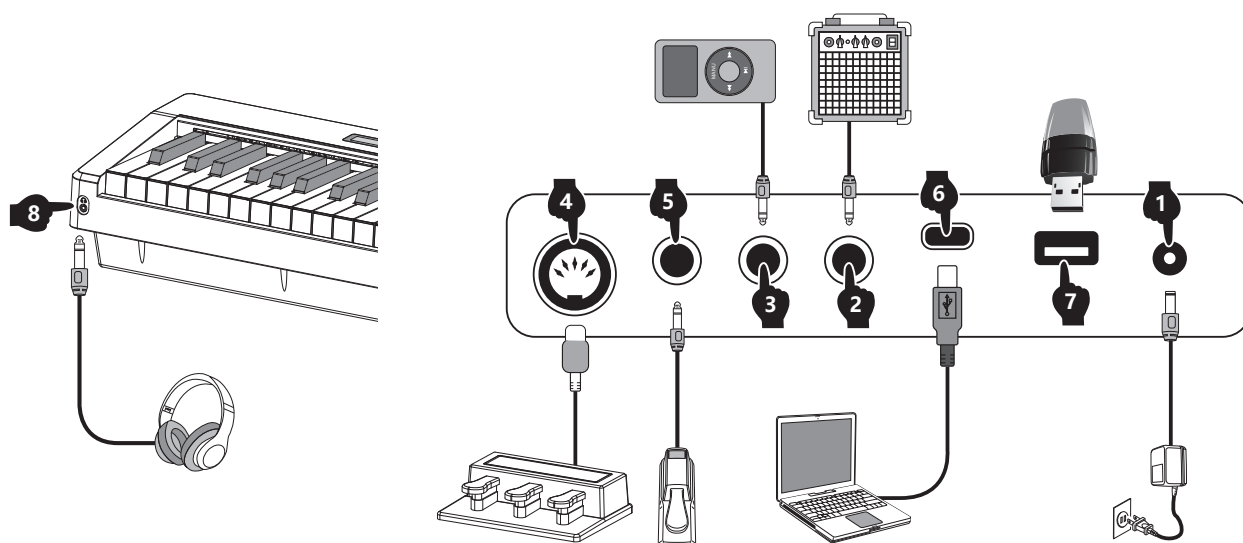

REMARK!

- This product is an electro-acoustic instrument product. It is normal that there is a little current sound in the speaker or earphone after power-on.
Keep away from "radio, TV, antenna receiver, router, refrigerator, TV, motor and other RF electrical interference sources" during use.



TERMINAL DIAGRAM



1 Power cord port

Connect the power cord as shown in the diagram, with one end plugged into a DC socket and the other end plugged into a 100-240V household power outlet (Figure 1)

2 By audio output port

The audio output jack can be connected to external active speakers and amplifier devices. (Figure 2)

3 Audio Input Port

The audio input jack can be connected to external audio sources for playback (such as MP3, linear audio signal input for mobile phones, etc.). (Figure 3)

4 Three pedal port

Connect the three pedals, and the sound control sequence for pressing the three pedals is: soft tone, trailing tone, and trailing tone. (Figure 4)

5 Yanyin pedal port

Connect the sustain pedal and press the pedal to control the effect of sound extension. (Figure 5)

6 USB MIDI port

The USB MIDI interface can be used to connect and interact with music devices with MIDI. By using pre installed music software on computers, tablets, and mobile phones, users can learn or play the keyboard for functions such as playing, composing, and storing. (Figure 6)

7 USB Flash drive port

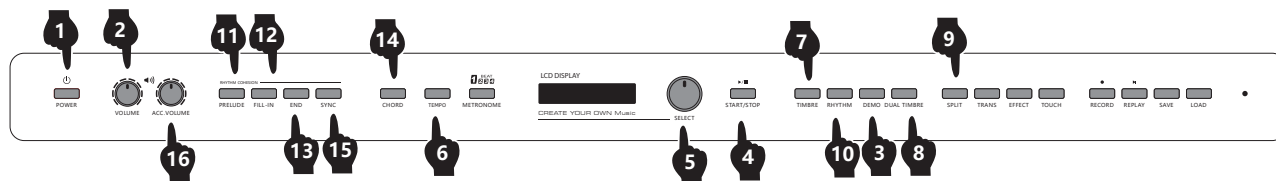
Store MP3, WMA USB flash drives in audio formats such as MP4, WAV, FLAC, and ACC can be inserted for automatic playback. (Figure 7)

8 Earphone port

Connecting headphones can monitor the details of changes during performance and automatically cut off the built-in speakers, without disturbing others during performance. (Figure 8)



OPERATION GUIDE



1 POWER ON/OFF

Press the "POWER" button, the indicator lights up, enters the open state, and press again to close. (Fig. 1)

- Processor chips of this product are complex, similar to computer systems. Sometimes they can not respond. Please turn off the power switch and then turn it on to work properly.

2 MASTER VOLUME

Turn the "VOLUME" knob to adjust the total volume to a satisfactory position. (Fig. 2)

3 DEMONSTRATION MUSIC PLAYING

1. Press the "DEMO" button to enter the music playing mode. (Fig. 3)
 2. Press the "START / STOP" button to start or stop the music playing. (Fig. 4)
 3. Turning the "Select" knob to select the music to be played, and the screen will display the code and name of the selected music. (Fig. 5)
 4. Press the "TEMPO" button and then rotate the "Select" knob to change the music playback speed. (Fig. 6)
- There are 100 songs in total. Please refer to the attached demo table for the name of the songs.

4 INSTRUMENT TIMBRE

SELECT INSTRUMENT TIMBRE:

1. Press the "TIMBRE" button to enter the instrument timbre selection mode. (Fig. 7)
 2. Turning the "Quick Select" knob to select the timbre of the instrument, and the selected timbre code and name will be displayed on the screen. (Fig. 5)
- there are 238 timbres in total. Please refer to the appendix tone table for the timbre name of the musical instrument.

SET DUAL TIMBRE:

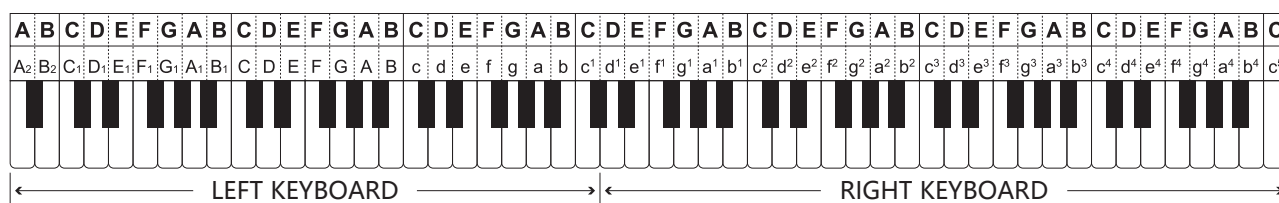
1. In tone mode, first select a tone as the main instrument.
2. Press the "DUAL TIMBRE" button to start the dual tone mixing mode. (Fig. 8)
3. Turning the "Select" knob to select another instrument as the superimposed timbre. (Fig. 5)
4. Playing on the "KEYBOARD" can produce a mixed sound of two musical instruments.
5. Press the "DUAL TIMBRE" button again to exit the function.

SET KEYBOARD SPLIT:

1. In tone mode, first select one as the right keyboard instrument timbre.
2. Press the "SPLIT" button to enter the left and right keyboard instrument timbre segmentation mode. (Fig. 9)
3. Turning the "Select" knob to select another instrument as the timbre of the instrument on the left keyboard. (Fig. 5)
4. Play on the "KEYBOARD". At this time, the left and right sides of the keyboard emit different instrument sounds.
5. Press the "SPLIT" button again to exit the function.

5 ACCOMPANIMENT

SELECT RHYTHM:

1. Press the "RHYTHM" button to enter the rhythm selection mode. (Fig. 10)
 2. Turning the "Select" knob to select the rhythm style, and the selected rhythm code and name will be displayed on the screen. (Fig. 5)
 3. Press the "START / STOP" button to start playing the selected rhythm. Press again to stop playing. (Fig. 4)
- there are 200 rhythms in total. Please refer to the rhythm table in the appendix for the rhythm name.

PRELUDE:

1. First select the rhythm to be played, and then press the "PRELUDE" button to enter the standby mode. (Fig. 11)
2. Press the "START / STOP" button to start playing the prelude of the selected rhythm, and then play the selected rhythm. (Fig. 4)

INSERT INTERLUDE:

In the process of rhythm playing, press the "FILL-IN" button to insert a transitional interlude for the rhythm being played. (Fig. 12)

EPILOGUE:

During rhythm playback, press the "END" button to insert an endplay for the rhythm being played. After the endplay is finished, the rhythm playback will stop. (Fig. 13)

CHORDS:

Press the "CHORD" button, the left keyboard will switch to the chord keyboard area (1-34 keys from the left). At this time, play the left keyboard, and automatically recognize and play the chord according to the single finger or multi finger fingering method. Press again to exit this function. (Fig. 14)

SYNCHRONOUS START:

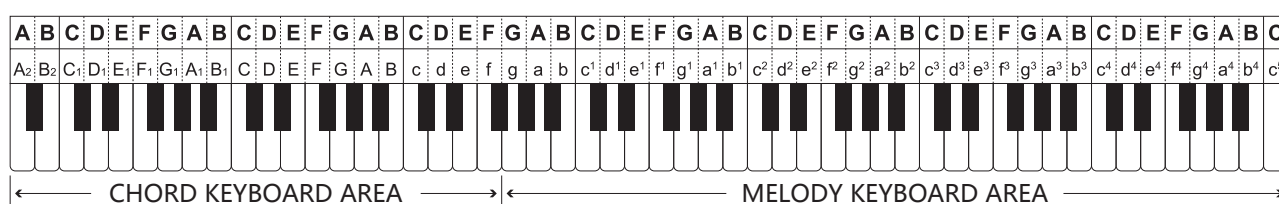
1. First select the rhythm to be played, and then press the "SYNC" button to enter the rhythm synchronization playing state. (Fig. 15)
 2. Press the piano key in the "CHORD KEYBOARD AREA" to trigger the rhythm to play synchronously.
- if "CHORD" is on, the chord and the selected rhythm will be played synchronously.

RHYTHM PLAYBACK SPEED:

Press the "TEPMO" button and then rotate the "Select" knob to change the rhythm playback speed. (Fig. 6)

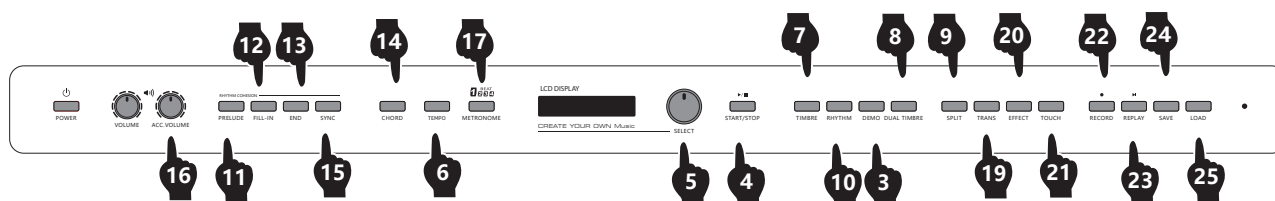
ACCOMPANIMENT VOLUME:

Turn the "ACC.VOL + -" knob to adjust the corresponding accompaniment volume. (Fig. 16)

6 METRONOME

1. Press the "metronome" button, the metronome function starts, and you can play the piano with the beat sound. (Fig. 17)
2. There are four types of metronomes, which can be switched by rotating the "SELECT" knob.
 - switching sequence: 1 / 4, 2 / 4, 3 / 4, 4 / 4, close, and cycle accordingly.
3. Press the "TEMPO" button and then rotate the "Select" knob to change the metronome playback speed. (Fig. 6)

8 KEYBOARD TRANS

- Press the "TRANS" button and then rotate the "Select" knob to adjust the keyboard pitch. This feature allows you to adjust the range of the entire keyboard by half a scale without changing the keyboard position. (Fig. 19)
- adjustment range: 12 semitones.

9 SOUND EFFECT

Press the "EFFECT" button to turn on reverberation. At this time, the sound of playing the piano has the sound wave reflection effect in the building. Press again to turn off this function. (Fig. 20)

10 KEYBOARD TOUCH

By default, the keyboard's touch sensitivity is turned on. When playing the keyboard, it will produce sound of corresponding volume according to the strength of your fingers, which facilitates the performance of music with different emotions. There are three options for this mode, namely "Soft", "Normal", and "Hard", which can be selected by continuously pressing the "TOUCH" button. Pressing the "TOUCH" button multiple times can disable this feature, and after disabling, the sound produced when playing the piano will reach its maximum volume (Fig. 21)

11 RECORD

1. Press the "RECORD" button, and the metronome sounds, entering the recording mode. (Fig. 22)
2. Play the piano for recording.
3. Press the "REPLAY" button to play the recorded music. (Fig. 23)
 - during recording, the timbre of the instrument can be changed for recording.

12 SAVE SETTINGS

1. Press the "SAVE" button to save the modified parameter setting, which is convenient for calling user-defined parameters. (Fig. 24)
 - parameters that can be saved: TIMBRE / RHYTHM / DEMO / TEMPO / TRANS / EFFECT.
2. Press the "LOAD" button to load the previously modified parameter settings. (Fig. 25)

PRODUCT MAINTENANCE

1 AVOID HEATING, DAMPNESS OR DIRECT SUNLIGHT

2 DO NOT USE NEAR THE TV OR RADIO

4 DO NOT SHAKE, AVOID COLLISION

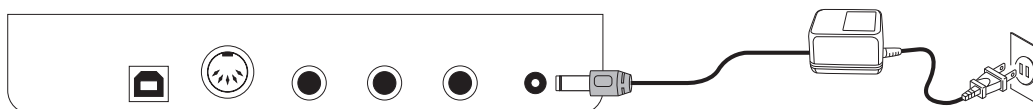
When moving, the product should be handled carefully and lightly. Violent vibration and collision are strictly prohibited in order to avoid damage to the shell or internal electronic components.
